

Campground Regulations

The management of Wolf Lodge Campground has adopted the following set of regulations to ensure the safety and enjoyment of our guests. As the need arises, these regulations may be amended. Our goal is to provide a safe, clean and pleasant atmosphere for our guests & staff.

CHECK OUT TIME: 11:00am. If you wish to stay longer please notify the office. **CHECK-IN TIME: 2:00pm**

QUIET HOURS: 10:00pm to 8:00am. Please no generators, music, loud conversations or any other noisy activities during these hours. Please show respect and courtesy for other guests' right to privacy and tranquility.

NO SMOKING OR PETS allowed in any of the cabins, restrooms or office.

GENERAL GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. AT ALL TIMES, parents are responsible for their children's safety and welfare, and minors must be under direct supervision of an adult.
2. **GENERATORS: Please do not run generators in the campground at any time, except for emergencies.**
3. We ask that consumption of alcoholic beverages be done in a responsible and discrete manner.
4. **Please maintain a 5-MPH SPEED LIMIT.** Drive cautiously and watch for children and animals.
5. No clotheslines allowed, for the safety of our guests. Dryers are available in the laundry room.
6. Please no washing vehicles or RV's on the premises.
7. If you lose your cabin key, a fee of \$10.00 will be assessed to replace the key.
8. The paying registered guest is responsible for any damages incurred to the campground facilities or grounds by themselves, their pets, visitors, or any member of their party.
9. The campground will not be held liable for accidents, injuries or loss by fire, theft or any act of nature. Please notify us if any hazardous conditions are found.
10. Please put trash in bags and deposit in the trash receptacles provided. **Do not burn trash** in the fire pits.

CHECK-IN & CANCELLATION POLICY:

ALL CAMPERS AND VISITORS MUST REGISTER AT THE OFFICE. There is a charge for extra persons and vehicle parking. Visitors may only visit after 8:00am and must leave the park by 10:00 PM. Please make your visitors aware of this and all campground policies.

1. Total payment for camping/lodging site is due upon check-in. Discounts must be requested during check-in.
2. To avoid cancellation fee of ENTIRE RESERVATION:
 - **Reservation must be canceled by PHONE ONLY**
 - At least 3 days (for cabins) prior to arrival date
 - At least 2 days (for RV or Tent sites) prior to arrival date

PLEASE BE AWARE THERE ARE NO REFUNDS AFTER CHECKING IN.

FIRES & CAMP FIRES

1. Fires are permitted inside the fire rings only. Please do not move the fire rings. Wood is sold at the camp store for \$6.00/bundle. PLEASE DO NOT GATHER WOOD OR BRUSH from the mountainside!
2. No fuel burning appliances (lanterns, heaters, stoves, etc.) may be used inside or on the decks of the cabins.
3. Fires in the fire rings should only be knee high...NO BON-FIRES!!
4. **DO NOT LEAVE FIRES UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME!!!** You are responsible for any fire that you start and any damage that results thereof. PLEASE USE EXTREME CAUTION.
5. All fires should be extinguished COMPLETELY before retiring.
6. **All facilities are NON-SMOKING.** Please dispose of extinguished cigarettes in designated containers only.

PARKING: Please park your car or tow vehicles in your site only. Do not park in an adjacent site even if it is unoccupied. Please ask at office if you need additional parking space. We have an over-flow parking site for extra vehicles, boats, trailers, etc.

PETS: All pets **MUST** be kept on a leash. **You are responsible for picking up and disposing of all pet droppings.** Please restrain dogs from barking. **Pets are not allowed in the cabins, restrooms or office.**

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE PETS UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME. Pets cannot be left outside unattended at any time during the day and must be confined inside owners RV, Trailer, or Tent at night.

FISHING: Please check state regulations as they change each year.

PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE CREEK - THERE IS NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY
ALL BOATING AND SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK

NOTICE: The camper accepts camping privileges with the understanding that he does hereby release the Campground, its officers and employees of all liability for loss or damage to property and injury to his person arising out of his use of its camping facilities, and agrees to indemnify the Campground, its officers and employees, against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury to the person of any member of the family or guest of the registered camper arising out of the use of its camping facilities.
